Information for our Guests

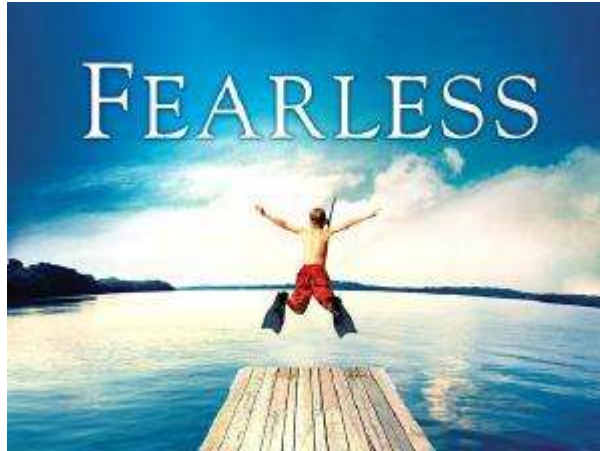
1. **What can I expect?** Our worship typically lasts an hour and 10 minutes. During this time, we'll have singing, prayers, communion and a message from the Bible.
