A Word from Russ...

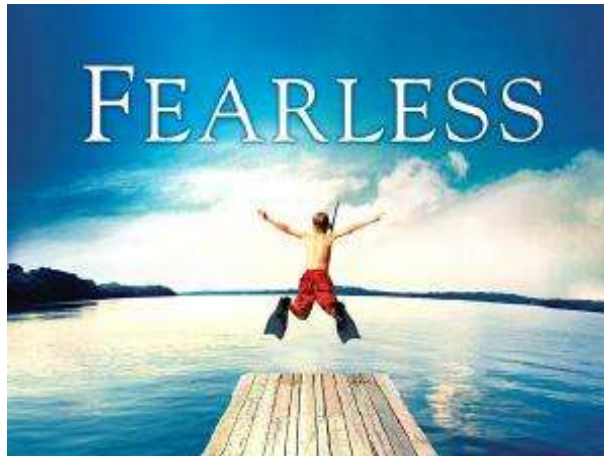
Thank you so much for joining us on Easter Sunday! We hope that you find the service to be encouraging and uplifting.
