Today we welcome Dr. Randy Lowry to Maury Hills! He'll be speaking at both services and at a noon luncheon that we're hosting for Lipscomb alumni, current students and prospective students. Here's a little bit about Dr. Lowry.

Dr. Lowry took office as Lipscomb University's 17<sup>th</sup> president on Sept. 26, 2005. Before that he served as a professor of law at Pepperdine University and founded the nationally-recognized Straus Institute for Dispute Resolution.

During his tenure a new College of Pharmacy has been established creating the first Lipscomb doctorate degree, sixteen new graduate programs have been developed, and four new institutes have been founded. He's also overseen the opening of the Burton Health Sciences Center, the Thomas James McMeen Music Center and the renovation of Collins Alumni Auditorium.

Dr. Lowry is married to Rhonda and they have three children—John, Janet and Melinda.
