This is the last Sunday for the Belize Team to be with us. They'll be gone the next two weeks. Next Sunday (6/20), they'll be worshipping with congregations in Belmopan, Burrell Boom and Belize City. The Sunday after that (6/27), they'll be wrapping up the trip with some relaxation on the island of Ambergris Caye. In between those days they'll be a lot of sweat, work and service.

While in Belize the team will be visiting schools where we sponsor Dream 514 kids. They'll deliver the scholarship money and backpacks to 27 different schools representing more than 100 sponsored kids. They'll set up a medical clinic Monday through Thursday in Belmopan with physicians, nurses, a pharmacy and dentist. It will be slammed all four days because people can't afford basic health care. They'll be building an addition to a home in a neighboring village.
